

Release Notes

Changes

- Create New Song and Song Asset Manager now share only 'StartSongRange' and 'EndSongRange'. The legacy 'StartShowRange' and 'EndShowRange' variables have been removed.
- In 'Song_Setup' Macro, the line preceding the Off-command lines now receives a two-second Wait value.
- 'Required Song ID and Song Name' warnings are shown only from the main Apply action.
- The SongID Search dialog scrollbar is now aligned to the frame edge.
- Focus order for input fields in the Main UI now progresses from first input field to last input field, respecting the presence / absence of optional input fields.
- Console 'Please' key will now action Apply once focus sequence is at the last available input field.

New Features

- The title bar now provides a dedicated Settings button. Settings control the shared Song Macro range and new optional Track BPM and Song Timecode Start input fields. Optional fields use the appropriate numeric and timecode input calculators and store their current values as Global Variables 'TrackBPM' and 'TCStart'.
- New Song Macros persist their enabled Track BPM and Timecode Start values in their own Global Variable command lines.
- The Search dialog presents Song Macros in a bordered, left-aligned table sorted by Song ID and conditionally adds Track BPM and Timecode Start columns determined by the optional input fields applied.
- 'Song_Setup' creation now prompts for its Macro Object number, prefilled with the first free Macro after 'EndSongRange'.
Occupied or invalid entries are indicated by red text and cannot be applied.
Macro Lines are now inserted through the Lua object API. The Track BPM command uses a Speed Master handle expression, and both optional command lines begin disabled before Settings synchronization.
- An existing Speed Master 15 labelled `TrackBPM` is preferred. Otherwise, the first Speed Master already carrying that label is reused. Speed Master 15 is labelled 'TrackBPM' only when no existing match is found. Optional 'TrackBPM' and 'TCStart' lines within 'Song_Setup' have their Enabled states updated

through Macro Line object handles and command-value matching rather than fixed line numbers.

- The Main and Settings dialogs now resize cleanly as optional input fields are applied.

Licencing

- This release version now silently reports its installed plugin version during an available licence-server exchange. Offline USB licensing remains unchanged.
- The signed USB lease permits up to 90 days of offline use. A one-calendar-day rollback tolerance accommodates normal time zone changes. On the fifth separate date mismatch, the plugin licence certificate is retired, and normal licence activation is requested. The authenticated incident record is sent to the server after the next successful online registration.

Bug Reporting and Feature Requests

While every effort is made to beta test and squash all bugs, sometimes, a bug or behavioural issue may slip through into public release. Please report any bugs with as much information as possible, as soon as possible.
